Jefferson City, MO – Mike Kehoe, small businessman and Republican candidate for the 6<sup>th</sup> District State Senate seat, announced the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter accomplishments of his campaign today. Kehoe collected \$103,581 for the quarter ending March 31. This brings the campaign's total funds raised since July 16 to \$312,260. Kehoe continues to be encouraged by the response the campaign has received from voters throughout the 6<sup>th</sup> District which includes Callaway, Cole, Miller, Moniteau and Morgan Counties. "The people of the 6<sup>th</sup> District continue to express concern about the economic situation facing our state and nation. They are excited about seeing a fresh face in the state capitol with real world experience and a small business background. Voters desperately want to see the focus shift toward growing the economy, which starts with employment growth in public and private sector jobs. My background in small business is the right fit for job growth in central Missouri."

"Candidate filing for the 6<sup>th</sup> District closed on March 30 without a Democratic challenger. It is fitting that my name is listed last in the ballot order because ultimately our campaign's focus is on the bottom line! The only time you have to be first is August 3<sup>rd</sup> and that is exactly how we are preparing. The primary is approaching fast and our team will not be outworked. Our momentum continues to grow and is evidenced by our expanding volunteer base, financial support, call responses and growing participation on our website. Our website had over 1,604 visits this quarter for a total of 4,433 visits since the site went up in August."

"Since announcing my candidacy on July 16, I have spent the last 259 days talking to voters throughout the five counties in the 6<sup>th</sup> District. In the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2010 alone, our volunteers made over 5,700 phone calls to solicit input directly from the voters of the 6<sup>th</sup> District. They have consistently expressed the desire to see a fresh new face in the state capitol who will fight to grow central Missouri jobs, stimulate growth in our economy, and fight to keep health care affordable," Kehoe said.

In closing, Kehoe reiterated his appreciation to those who have stepped up to help at this stage of the campaign. "I am both blessed and excited to report that literally hundreds of people have signed up to volunteer on the website at [www.mikekehoeforsenate.com](http://www.mikekehoeforsenate.com) and we have had 700 donors since July who have offered their financial support. I am proud to report that in the last three months we participated in county Lincoln Day festivities throughout the District and attended a total of 99 events. In addition, we raised a total of \$103,581 in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2010. I continue to be humbled by those who are willing to give their time, talents, and hard earned money to support our campaign efforts."
